

Mark 3:22-30

"But whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven; he is guilty of an eternal sin." He said this because they were saying, "He has an evil spirit." (Mark 3:29-30, NIV)

<u>Blasphemy</u> = To speak ill of or mock the work, the words, or the character of a deity.

The unpardonable sin is not :

- 1. <u>Cursing</u>, <u>mocking</u> or <u>making fun</u> of the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Using <u>God's name</u> in <u>vain</u>.

3. <u>Suicide</u>.

<u>Blasphemy</u> against the Holy Spirit is <u>resisting</u> the Holy Spirit's <u>work</u> in your life so that <u>lesus</u> cannot be <u>revealed</u> for who He is.
