GOD'S WILL

3 WAYS TO MISS GOD'S WILL:

1. I <u>over-spiritualize</u> God's will.

(Matthew 16:1-4, NIV)

If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him (James 1:5, NIV)

2. I tend to overanalyze it.

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. (Hebrews 11:6, NIV)

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. (Proverbs 3:5-6, NIV)

3. I <u>assume</u> that "hard" means wrong.

It is better, if it is God's will, to suffer for doing good than for doing evil. (1 Peter 3:17, NIV)





THREE WAYS TO MISS GOD'S WILL

Where am I waiting for a sign when God has already given me a step?

Where am I overthinking and need to grow in faith?

Where is God calling me to trust Him enough to risk something?

Where is God calling me to take a risk and I'm holding back?
