Genesis 6

To overcome this corrupt world:

1. I walk with God.

But Noah found favor in the eyes of the Lord. (Genesis 6:8, NIV)

- 2. I live a life of faith.
- 3. I live my <u>life</u> in <u>obedience</u> to <u>God</u>.
 - · Noah had 2 jobs:
 - 1. His first job was to build the ark.

So make yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out. This is how you are to build it: The ark is to be 450 feet long, 75 feet wide and 45 feet high. Make a roof for it and finish the ark to within 18 inches of the top. Put a door in the side of the ark and make lower, middle and upper decks. (Genesis 6:14-16, NIV)

Noah did everything just as God commanded him. (Genesis 6:22, NIV)

2. He preached righteousness.

...he did not spare the ancient world when he brought the flood on its ungodly people, but protected Noah, a preacher of righteousness... (2 Peter 2:5b, NIV)
