The Resurrection

[Jesus] said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into the hands of men. They will kill him, and after three days he will rise." (Mark 9:31, NIV)

Why I should believe in the resurrection:

- 1. Because of the eyewitness accounts.
- 2. In the Biblical accounts, the first eyewitnesses are <u>women</u>, not <u>men</u>.
- 3. A resurrection is the only explanation of the transformation of the disciples from cowards to missionaries.
- 4. All other religious movements of that era died out when the leader died, but Christianity did not.
- 5. Jesus' followers suffered rejection, torture and death for this claim, yet that <u>did not stop them</u>.
- 6. James and Jude, the brothers of Jesus, came to believe that Jesus was the Messiah.
